**The Insurance cover for this event is “Basic”, there is no Personal Accident cover for Competitors and Liability cover in respect of any claim made by third parties is limited to £10 million and £5 million for Medical Mal-practice.**

**Definition:** Hare and Hounds is a controlled Group Start event which is a test of endurance and reliability. Competitors will be required to complete a number of laps within a time set by the organisers (Not Less than 2 hours).

**Eligibility:** ALL Riders MUST hold an ACU or SACU Licence and be a minimum of 16 years of age. Riders under 18 years require parental agreement form with entry form. ACU Licence will be checked at signing on. If you require a One Event day licence to be issued on the day you will need to send an extra £10.00 with your entry Fee. In Post or applied for will not be accepted. Any rider or passenger from another FMN MUST produce a licence issued by their FMN together with Start permission and proof of personnel accident insurance.

**Venue:** Chavenage Farm Tetbury Gloucester GL8 8XU

**Start:** Sportsman 2t & 4t, Clubman 2t & 4t Over50 10am 2 hour event.

Championship, Clubman Elite, Expert, Expert Over40 1pm 2.5 hour Event.

**Entries:** Must be on the correct ACU headed entry form together with the correct fee of **£50.00** and returned to the Secretary of the event with the correct fee. Close when full. **Day Entries £5.00 Extra ACU Day Licence Available £10**

**Entries to be sent to the Secretary of the Meeting by May 9th**

**Final Instructions/ Programme/ Entry List etc:** Riders must include **1 SAE** with entry for these

**Results:** Will be displayed on Organisers Web sites - Riders requiring results to be posted must include a **second SAE**

**Awards:** This is a round of the ACU British Cross Country Championship, and ACU awards will be presented at the end of the series.

**Cash awards will also be presented at the end of the series dependent on Sponsorship/Prize fund that has built up**

**Individual Event Awards:** The Organiser will be presenting the following awards for this particular round. £500 shared between 1st to 6th in the Championship class. Product prizes for Top 3 in all other classes.

**Course:** Approx 7 miles per lap Woodland, open going tracks and trails with surrounding areas which will provide a mixture of terrain including MX track type going.

**Machines:** Must be presented to the machine examiner at least 30 minutes before the Start then placed in the start area in the class start line applicable to the rider competing. Machines may be Enduro or MX. Lights/Speedo/horn and RTA requirements etc will not be tested for this event.

<p><b>Noise: MX 4 stroke machines MUST be fitted with an Enduro FIM spec silencer or approved DBA reducer.</b> Midwest MCC will turn away MX bikes fitted with excessively noisy exhaust systems.</p>

**Tyres:** MX, Enduro or Trials are permitted for machines

**Number Plates/Numbers:** Any contrasting combination of number and number plate may be used e.g. White Numbers on Blue/ Black/ Green plates or Black numbers on Yellow or White plates

**Refuelling:** Can only be done in the official refuelling area by rider's officials and authorised helpers. NO CHILDREN IN PITS/REFUELING AREA. ALL engines MUST be stopped during refuelling. Refuelling outside the official refuelling area will result in exclusion from the event with no exceptions. Outside Assistance will only be allowed in the pit area, except when provided on the course by the organisers. **Blue tape area WALKING PACE ONLY.**

**Lap Scoring:** The competitors will pass through a BLUE TAPE AREA at the end of each lap where the competitor's passage will be recorded by lap scoring officials. Riders number must be displayed on front and sides of machine and be clearly visible. Please ensure front number is stuck on firmly, **officials may need to clean your number!**

**Transponders:** If transponders are to be used please note as per ACU Enduro Standing Regs – 3.0

The onus on ensuring the device is correctly fitted will rest with the rider - If a fee/ deposit is required for transponder loan /hire – details will be given in the Final Instructions
